

Our annual Penny Auction will be held in the Corpus Christi Parish Center on Saturday, March 9, beginning at 7 PM. Our past several Penny Auctions have been huge successes. Each event brought more than 325 players with each resulting in more than a \$5000 profit for our school.

You can help us to make this year's event just as successful. If you have never attended a Penny Auction, it is a family friendly event with prizes for all ages. Participants purchase numbered cups for \$2 each and then bid on items by putting one to six pennies in their cups (the necessary number will be announced before each round). A number is drawn and the cup with that number is the winner. We try to have at least 75 - 85 prizes to auction off and like to include a good variety for all ages.

We depend upon donations from Corpus Christi parents and parishioners, as well as many local businesses to obtain all of our prizes. Most range from \$25 gift cards to sport's team memorabilia and almost anything in between. We are very much in need of prizes, especially for children. Any donation of a toy, art kit, sports item, etc. would be greatly appreciated. All we ask is that the items are new. Corpus Christi Scrip for any local business would be great, since the purchase of the scrip would also help our school.
