



CORPUS CHRISTI SCHOOL SAFETY PLAN

In Response to COVID-19



The mission of Corpus Christi School is to provide meaningful learning experiences so that students can grow spiritually, socially, intellectually, and emotionally in a Christian atmosphere. We are committed to providing an excellent education that challenges our students and giving them a solid Catholic foundation in a faith-filled environment. Each member of our school will have an important role in implementing these plans for a safe return to school.

These plans below were prepared to provide as much protection for students and teachers as possible while meeting all guidelines set by the CDC and Wheeling-Ohio County Health Department. If guidelines change, this plan may also change and be updated

Temperature Checks

Staff and students will have their temperatures checked on a daily basis prior to entering the building. Anyone with a temperature of 100F and above or other COVID-19 related symptoms must stay home from school or will be sent home. We ask parents to also check temperatures before sending your child to school

Wearing Masks

All staff and students will be required to wear a mask in restrooms, hallways and common areas where social distancing cannot be maintained. Classrooms will be set up with seating arranged 6 feet apart and forward facing to allow for social distancing.

Visitors

Visitors to the building will be limited as much as possible. All pre-approved visitors will enter through the main door to receive a temperature check and to sign in. Masks must be worn by visitors upon entering the building.

Classroom Pods

Students will remain with their classroom pod throughout the day. Middle school teachers will switch classrooms to allow for social distancing guidelines to be maintained at each grade level.

Hallways & common areas

Markers have been placed throughout the hallways and common areas in order for students to maintain a 6ft distance between one another. Classes will utilize all available spaces on a scheduled basis. Common spaces will be cleaned between classes.

Lunch and Recess

Classes will eat lunch in the cafeteria at socially distanced tables. A third lunch period will be added to allow for social distancing.

Outdoor breaks will be given throughout the day as the weather permits.

Cleaning & Disinfecting

Enhanced cleaning protocols have been established to disinfect the classrooms daily and deep clean weekly. Classrooms with multiple uses will be wiped down between each class. Staff will have all necessary supplies in their classrooms.

OCS Bus Transportation

At this time, we highly encourage parents or guardians to transport children to our school. Bus routes may be changing and limitations may be put into effect. If your son or daughter needs to utilize bus transportation, they will be required to wear a mask on the bus, receive a temperature check and wash their hands upon arrival at the school.

Early Dismissal

Parents needing to pick their child(ren) up for an early dismissal must call the school office. The school secretary or school representative will dismiss the child to their parents at the front doors of the school.

Regular Dismissal

Bus riders will wear a mask and wait for transportation on a designated spot in the cafeteria. Students who are being picked up will be required to wear a mask at dismissal and will be dismissed from the front of the school. We ask that parents maintain a safe and healthy distance between them at dismissal.

Gym Class

Students will still be attending a weekly gym class. If weather permits, gym will be held outside in the park. If an indoor space must be used, students will participate in activities that allow for social distancing. All items will be cleaned after class.

Other Specials

Art, gym, and music class will also be held on a weekly basis. Students will use their own supplies for these classes and community items will not be available. Students will remain in the classroom pod and will not mix with other classes.

Trips to the Main Office

Trips to the main office will be minimized. Teachers will each have an envelope outside their rooms for notes that need to be sent to the office. They will be picked up daily by 10:00am. Any student needing to visit the office will be required to wear a mask. All calls to parents will be made by the school secretary.

Restroom Breaks

Restrooms will have a limit of 2 persons at a time. Restroom passes will be located in each classroom. As a student enters the restroom, the pass will be placed on the door allowing other persons to know if they can enter. Each class will also have a designated restroom break time.

Weekly Mass

While the COVID-19 stipulations are still in place, weekly mass schedules will be created to allow students to attend mass 2 times a month. Students will be required to wear a mask and follow all guidelines when entering the church.

Sporting Events

Sports teams may begin practices on February 12th. Athletes must wear masks to and from practice. They must also have their own water bottle with their name marked. Sporting events will adhere to all state and local guidelines.

Fundraisers

Strategic social distancing will be observed for all gatherings, large or small. Fundraisers which require a gathering of people, have been put on hold at this time following the Governor's mandate of groups of 25. More information will come as state and local guidelines change.

Snow Days & Some Holidays

Corpus Christi School may still call 2 hour delays due to weather. Snow days will now become Virtual Learning Days which will allow us to continue teaching our students. Some holidays may be booked into our schedules as Virtual Learning Days. This will allow the students to have their holiday and enjoy a day at home; however, virtual learning will take place on that morning.

PLANS FOR RE-ENTRY
IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Corpus Christi will be following PLAN 1 to begin the school year. If local or state health departments or the governor requires a reduction in the capacity of our school facility or mandates a shutdown, we will be prepared to move into PLAN 2 or PLAN 3

PLAN 1

IN PERSON LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

All students at Corpus Christi School will attend a traditional, 5 day in person learning environment. Students will be kept in their core classroom pods throughout the day.

The cafeteria will be set at a 50% capacity and lunch periods will be added. Schedules will be created to allow teachers and students to utilize outside learning environments, labs, etc.

PLAN 2

MIXED LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Students at Corpus Christi will operate on a modified schedule which will allow for both in person learning and remote learning. More information to follow.

PLAN 3

REMOTE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Students will be learning only in a remote platform using Google Classroom and Google Meets. An updated schedule will be given where teachers will meet with classes via Google Meets on a daily basis. All work will be posted to Google Classroom by 9:00am and a regular schedule will be maintained.

SCREENING FOR COVID-19

Follow the guidelines below when screening your child for COVID-19. If your child:

HAS NO SYMPTOMS

PROCEED TO SCHOOL

EXPOSURE, BUT NO SYMPTOMS

CANNOT TO SCHOOL

If your child has been exposed to someone who got a positive result, they must stay home for 14 days.

DIAGNOSIS, BUT NO SYMPTOMS

CANNOT TO SCHOOL

Your child must stay home for 10 days since they received their positive COVID-19 Test result.

HAS AT LEAST ONE OF THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

Fever, Chills, Shortness of Breath, Loss of Smell or Taste

CANNOT TO SCHOOL

If your child has any of the symptoms, they must stay home until 10 days has passed since the first symptom and been fever free without medicine for 24 hours. Must also have had 3 days of symptom improvement.

If your child has been absent with any COVID-19 symptoms and received a **NEGATIVE** test result, this result must be sent into the school office upon your child's return to school.

If your child receives a diagnosis other than COVID-19, this doctor's excuse must also be sent into the school office upon your child's return to school.

REMOTE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT PLAN

In the event that Corpus Christi School must move to a remote learning environment, we will follow a daily schedule that will allow for a smooth transition.

All students in grades Pre-School through 8th grade are required to meet daily with their HOMEROOM TEACHER at a 10:00am Google Meet. Attendance will be taken so anyone not on the Google Meet will be marked ABSENT for the day. The morning Google Meet will start the day with Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance then discuss the assignments for the day. All assignments will be posted to the Google Classroom by 9am.
